The BC Sports Hall of Fame's *Hero In You*® education program is now touring schools across the province. With over 25,000 artifacts and 20,000 archival documents representing over 100 years of sporting accomplishments in British Columbia, we can tailor our presentations to your specific community and its unique history.

Witness legendary Hall of Fame athletes speak directly to your students about their personal experiences of overcoming personal obstacles and handicaps, the pain of defeat and the thrill of success. Hall of Fame facilitators also deliver a PowerPoint presentation that covers a variety of themes including leadership, social responsibility, bullying, teamwork, positive thinking, self-confidence, determination and courage.

Typical sessions last 1 ½ hours including time for questions, photographs and sharing of artifacts. Talks can be delivered in individual classrooms or before school assemblies.

PRESENTATION OVERVIEW

Pre-Classroom Visit

- A classroom teacher (between Grades 2 through 8) contacts the BC Sports Hall of Fame
- A Hall of Fame facilitator will introduce and explain the *Hero In You*® Education Program to the classroom teacher
- A Hall of Fame facilitator will provide suggestions of which *Hero In You*® units/lesson plans are most appropriate, and encourage the class to complete least 3 lessons prior to the classroom visit
- Teacher submits a completed *Hero In You*® In The Classroom registration form and highlights any special needs and/or expectations
- A few days prior to the visit, teachers are encouraged to have their students complete a *Hero In You*® In The Classroom activity sheet

Classroom Visit (1 ½ hour total length)

- A Hall of Fame facilitator will arrive 30 minutes prior to classroom session to set-up
- A Hall of Fame facilitator will deliver a 30-45 minute PowerPoint talk
- Approximately 5 themes and values are presented through the stories of British Columbia athletes who best exemplify them (Terry Fox, Rick Hansen, etc)
- Artifacts are presented (subject to availability)
- A Hall of Fame Inductee will deliver a 20-30 minute talk, including time for student questions and photographs (guest appearance subject to availability)
- Students complete a short *Hero In You*® In The Classroom activity sheet/questionnaire
- Students gather for a group photograph with artifacts and Hall of Fame Inductee

Post-Classroom Visit

- Teacher submits a completed evaluation form
- Classroom teacher receives an Class of Champions certificate
- A Hall of Fame facilitator will contact the teacher and thank them, as well as solicit any feedback to help improve the program
- Teachers are encouraged to have their students respond to the *Hero In You*® In The Classroom presentation through artwork, essays, etc. and share copies with the BC Sports Hall of Fame
- Teachers are encouraged to continue to use additional *Hero In You*® lesson plans and activity sheets

NOTES

- The Hall of Fame facilitator will bring a video projector, laptop, artifacts (subject to availability), gloves for handling artifacts, extension power cords and a camera to document the presentation
- The school is expected to provide a projection screen or clean surface upon which to project video, as well as an electrical outlet to power the electronic devices
